DJ SHOW TECHNICAL SPECIFICATION

The following technical rider is a MINIMUM specification, if these specifications are not met this will result in NO PERFORMANCE.

DJ REQUIREMENTS

We will need from you:

- One (1) Pioneer DJM-900 NEXUS 2 (DJM-900NXS2) DJ mixer
- Four (4) Pioneer CDJ-2000 NEXUS 2 (CDJ-2000NXS2), linked via Ethernet hub
- Two (2) monitor speakers – Mackie SRM-450 or similar, adjustable through mixer

It is absolutely necessary for the show that the CDJ's and the DJM are NEXUS editions with fully functional USB ports.



ADDITIONAL RIDER AND BOOTH SETUP INSTRUCTIONS

- All equipment must be in high quality and in full working condition without any defects and with presence of full connection which allows usage of all functions
- A professionally trained sound man on site for the entire set. Sound system must be up to the artist's standards (loud enough for the size of the room, clear sound, plenty of bass, no sound bleed from other stages or rooms). Artist reserves the right to have people removed from the stage during the performance. If the technical rider is not to exact specification the artist reserves the right to cancel the performance at any time without penalty.
- Stage area shall be stable and structurally safe. Artist reserves the right, without liability, of refusal to use any equipment which they feel is unfit, unsafe or does not meet the agreed specifications for the engagement.

SECURITY

The well being of artist's equipment is the promoter's responsibility when artist is not present. Promoter is responsible for the security of the equipment and assigning security guards to prevent theft or tampering.

SOUND CHECK

A sound check is not always necessary if the show has been advanced and cleared, however, in situations where clarification is necessary a brief sound check before doors open may be required.

ACCOMMODATION

Hotel Room with 1 queen size bed and late check out. Breakfast and free internet access included.

HOSPITALITY

The following must be provided to the artist free of charge:

2 x hot meals or \$50 dinner buyout (whichever is easiest for the promoter)

6 x bottled water

2 x Red bull cans

2 x sweat towel

1 x veggie platter

1 x pack of Lucky Strikes

OTHER REQUIREMENTS

- Lights, monitors and PA must be provided, setup and broken down by promoter
- Transportation to and from airport and venue must be provided. If the promoter is unable to provide transportation adequate cab fare, including tip, will be provided by promoter

DECLARATION

We are happy to discuss and consider any reasonable request to amend the terms of this rider. However, no such amendment will be valid unless agreed in writing by the artist's representation. If there has been no contact between local production crew and the artist's representation before show date, please do not question any of the above on show day. If the technical rider requirements have not been met on the arrival of the artist then they can reserve the right not to perform.
